parents to drive carefully around the school. We also requested that our pedestrian crossings can be repainted. Some of the traffic offences around the school are done by our own parents. There are also other road users who do not obey the traffic rules and we would appreciate any help to get the Metro Police involved around the school.

We urge parents to obey the rules and not to do the following:

- Don't drop your child in front of the school gates, especially the gate at the Tennis courts or the gate at the school hall. This makes it difficult if a person drives out off the schools gates, because it is nearby the pedestrian crossing.
- If your child is in Grade 1-2, don't drop them off across the road to cross the street on their own.
- Don't stop in the middle of the road with your hazards on, to drop your child off. This makes other road users angry.
- Don't park on the pavement. This forces pedestrians to walk in the road.
- Don't drive fast in Jan van Riebeeck and Koos de La Rey Streets.
- Don't be rude to the traffic assistants, they are there to help.
- Don't make a U-turn after you dropped your child off.

Suggestions:

- Let your child wait ten minutes on the pavilion and pick your child up 10 minutes later in the afternoons. The traffic is less then.
